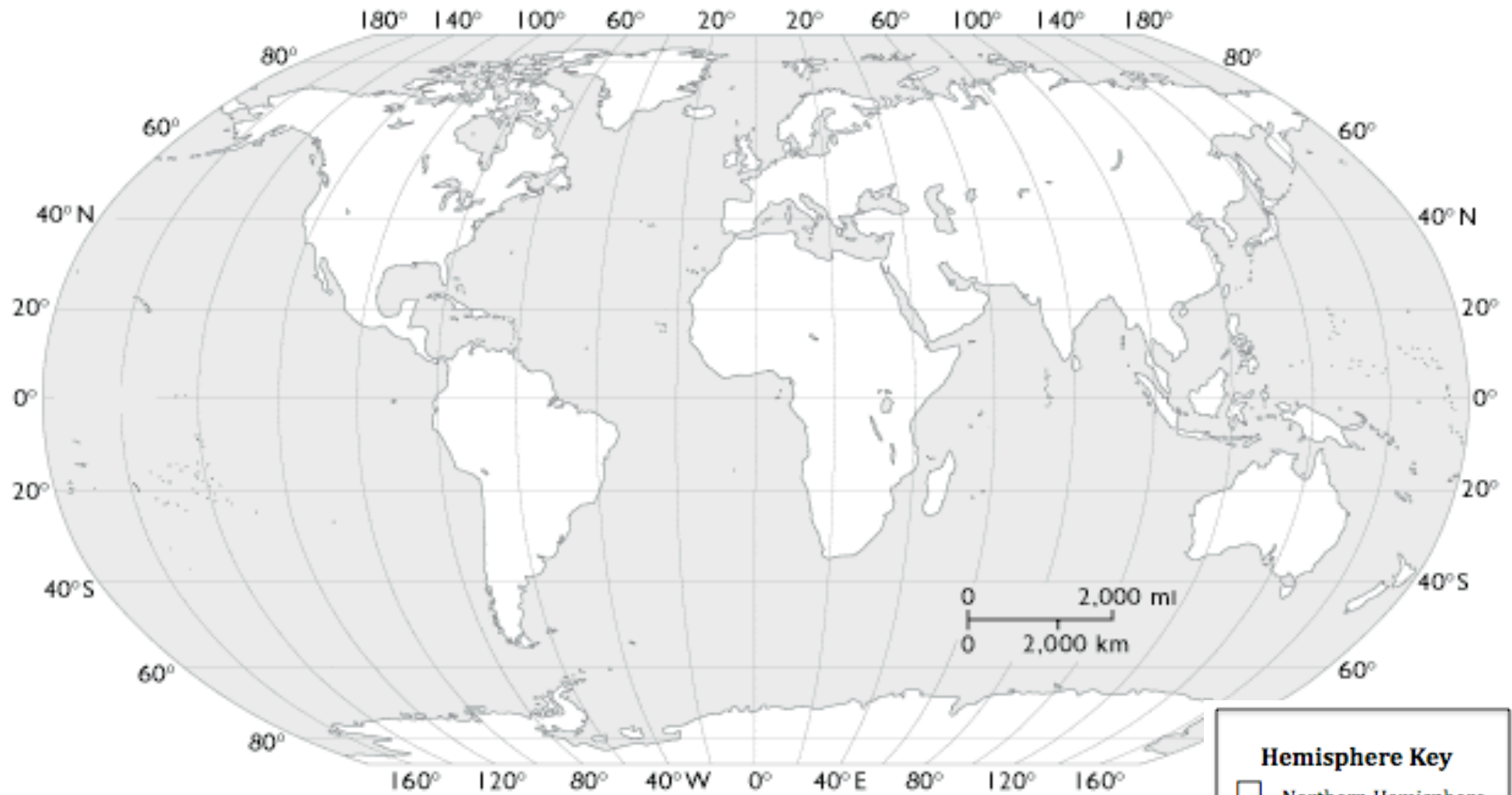

****Helpful Hint:** Remember the Equator splits the world into two pieces. The Northern Hemisphere is north of the equator and the Southern Hemisphere is to the south of the Equator. The Prime Meridian also splits the world into two pieces. The Western Hemisphere is to the west of the Prime Meridian and the Eastern Hemisphere is to the east of the Prime Meridian. In this class we focus on civilizations in the Eastern Hemisphere 😊
